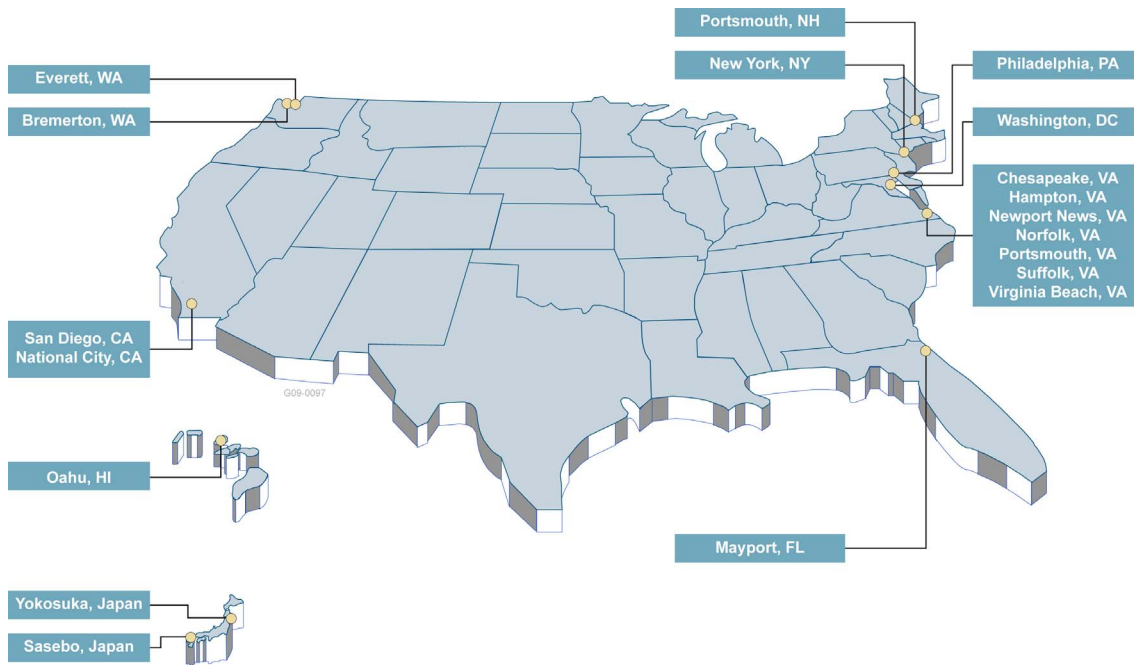
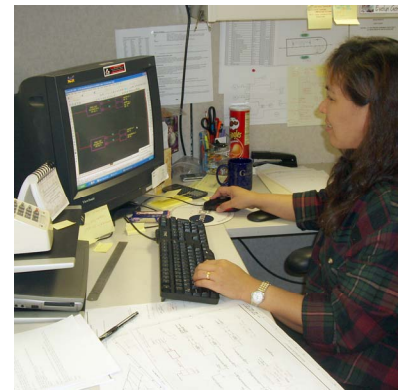


AMSEC Overview
